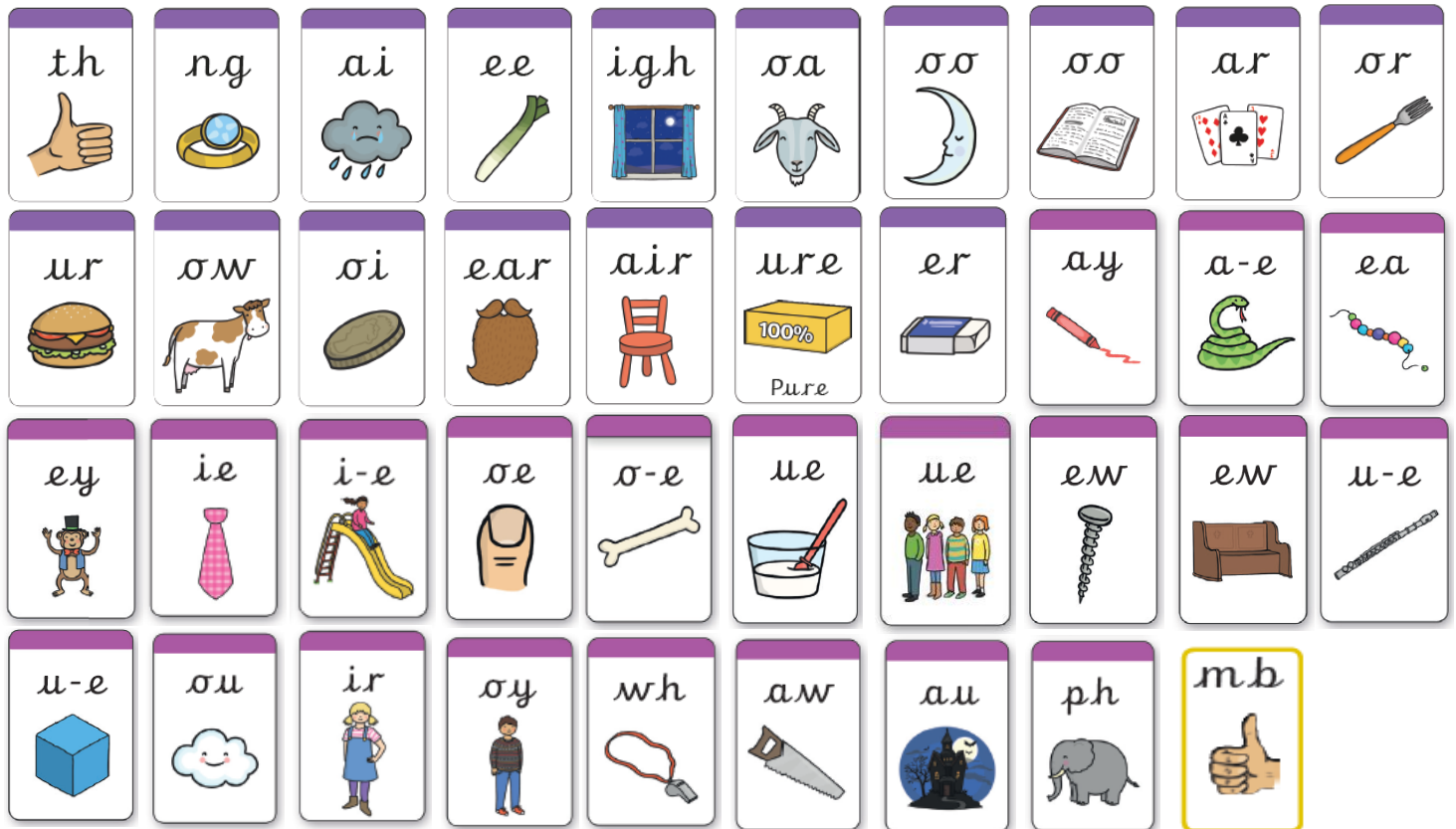


Miss Price's Phonics Group (week beginning 22nd June)

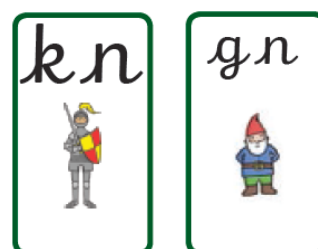
Remember you can't sound them out. Can you remember our actions?
