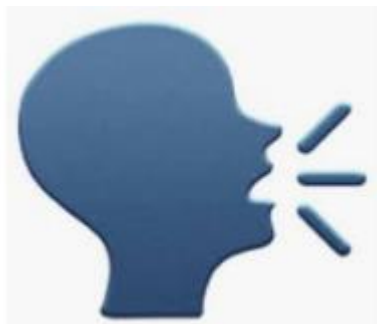
New spelling rule! - /zh/ sound spelled with a 's'
