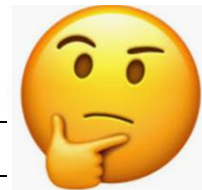


Mr Underwood's Phonics Group (week beginning 18th May)

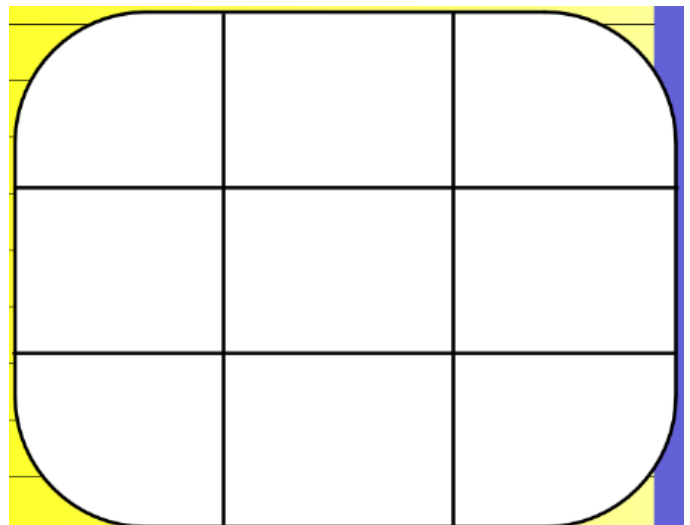
ar makes an /or/ sound after the **w**
