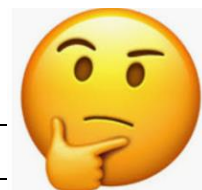


Mr Underwood's Phonics Group (week beginning 11th May)

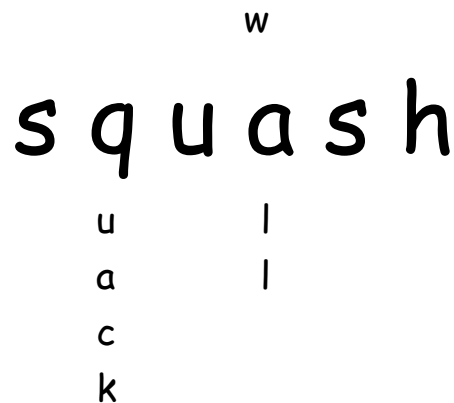
2) Practice writing these spellings correctly using a spelling machine to help you.
