New spelling rule! - The 'ee' sound spelt -ey

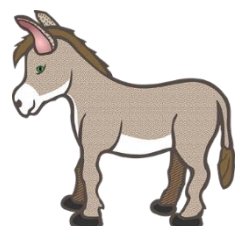
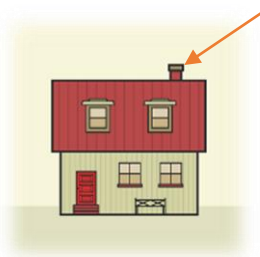
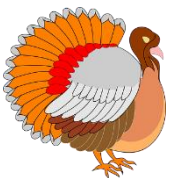
Firstly, can you think of any words that this spelling rule applies to?

- 2) Next, can you **write down/say** what you can see? Remember to apply our new spelling rule.



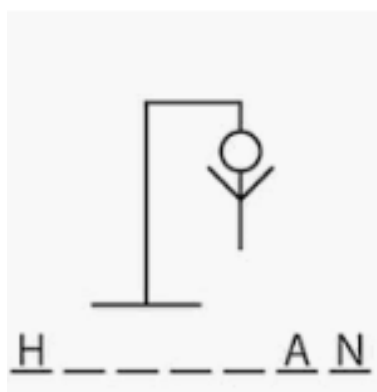
3) You can now practice writing these spellings correctly using a spelling machine to help you.
