Remember - We are adding 'est or er' to the root word ending in an 'e' if it has a consonant before it.

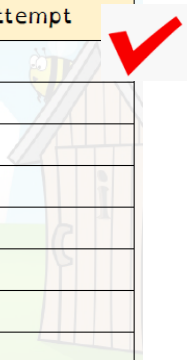
