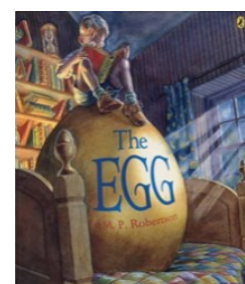
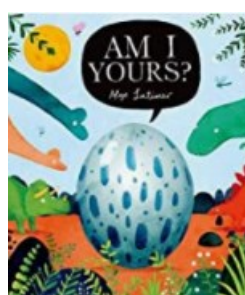
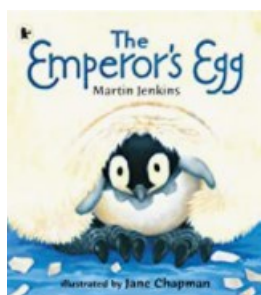
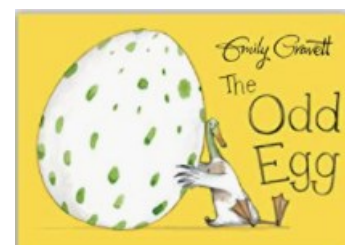
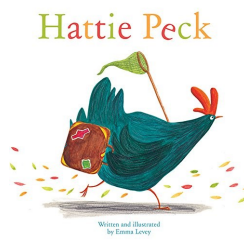
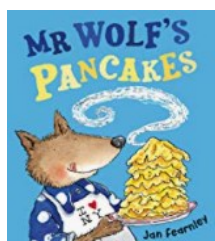
Our topic this term is called, 'Out of the Egg.' As usual, we will link as much of our learning as possible to our topic and we are expecting a lot of dinosaur experts/scientists/palaeontologists to emerge and help us on our way.

Last week, we received an incubator and fertilised eggs to hatch.
